<p>Drop Box or In person at</p> <p>AMERICAN BANK 115 FRONT STREET BEAVER DAM, WI</p>	<p>If you wish to pay tax bills at American Bank, you can drop them in the night depository located on the front of the building at any time. Please place the payment stub, your check, and if you would like a receipt, you must include a self-addressed stamped envelope prior to placing it in the night depository. You can also pay in person, with all the above information, inside American Bank. If you have any questions, feel free to contact a Customer Service Representative at (920)885-2700 during normal business hours. If paying with an escrow check and have a refund coming, the Town of Beaver Dam will issue the refund via US Mail.</p>

2026 Schedule for Bulk Waste and Metals Collection

TOWN OF BEAVER DAM RESIDENTS USING GARBAGE ASSESSMENT

From 8:00am – 12:00pm on the following dates, dumpsters will be available for bulk waste and metals disposal at the Town Hall located at W8540 County Road W. This service is available for all residents that receive and pay for garbage assessment through the Town of Beaver Dam. Residents that **DO NOT** receive or pay for garbage assessment will be able to pay by the car/trailer load at the gate. The cost of this being \$20 per trip and per unit. Unit being defined as one vehicle or one trailer. All residents are required to show proof of residency at the gate before entering.

PLEASE NOTE: ONLY Bulk waste drop off will be allowed from 8:00am – 12:00pm. The driveway will be closed outside of those hours.

No construction/roofing materials, appliances, tree limbs, tires, oil, fluorescent lights, freezers, air conditioners, paints or household chemicals. For items not collected (i.e. construction materials, tires, appliances, etc.) or disposal of items outside of these dates, and for current rates, please contact:

The Town of Beaver Dam has a **Yard Waste** dump site located at the Town Hall. The dump site will be open Saturdays only from 8-12pm April 18 until October 31, excluding holiday and bulk waste weekends. *Yard Waste (lawn clippings, leaves, garden materials) and Brush.* **RESIDENTS ONLY – NO CONTRACTORS.** **Sticks/limbs are not to exceed 4 inches in diameter and 6 feet in length. NO stumps or root balls.**

Violators WILL be fined up to \$1,000.

The Town reserves the right to close the dump site when the budget for the year has been met. Notice will be provided on the town's website and a sign at the Town Hall gate.



Christmas Tree drop-off will be available January 10th from 8-12pm at the Town Hall.

There will be NO curbside pickup.



CURBSIDE PICK UP OF RECYCLING GUIDELINES:

All items below must be rinsed clean and placed unbagged in the proper recycling container provided by the collection agency.

MIXED CONTAINERS: aluminum cans and clean aluminum foil, tin cans, steel cans, aerosol cans, empty/dried paint cans, glass bottles and jars, #1-7 plastic, milk cartons, juice boxes, soup cartons

MIXED PAPER: Newspaper, magazines, books, mail, school/office paper, brown corrugated cardboard, gray chipboard (cereal & shoe boxes), brown paper bags, shredded paper (bagged in clear plastic)

DO NOT PUT THE FOLLOWING ITEMS IN THE RECYCLING CART: Styrofoam of any kind, trash, construction materials, clothing, yard waste, household hazardous waste, electronics
